Notice of Public Hearing

Pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Section 4301:06, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission is required to hold no fewer than 4 public hearings each year for the purposes of hearing general comments and complaints as to its policies, adopted pursuant to Chapters 4301 and 4303 of the Ohio Revised Code, of receiving suggestions with respect thereto and for the dissemination of information to the public. Additionally the Commission will consider other business including the adoption of policies and procedures, and a Resolution authorizing staff to initial file the following rules under five year review with CSI and JCARR:

- 4301:1-1-02 Definitions
- 4301:1-1-15 Permits, cancellation of
- 4301:1-1-46 Miscellaneous restrictions
- 4301:1-1-47 Ban on refilling bottles or selling brands not ordered
- 4301:1-1-48 Service in hotel rooms
- 4301:1-1-49 Hours of sale of alcoholic beverages
- 4301:1-1-50 Limitations on happy hours and similar retail price reductions
- 4301:1-1-55 Possession of spirituous liquor on certain premises prohibited
- 4301:1-1-58 Exceptions to giving away food
- 4301:1-1-59 Solicitation of patrons
- 4301:1-1-61 Violation – identification and notification

In compliance with this provision, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission will hold a public hearing on **Friday, September 11 at 10:30 am**. The public hearing will be held at the Riffe Center at 77 South High Street, 19th floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215. Anyone who wishes to speak to the issues of Commission policy or wishes to make comments to the Commission relating to its business may do so at this time.
