**Notice of Quarterly Public Hearing and Rules Review**

Pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Section 4301.06, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission is required to hold no fewer than 4 public hearings each year for the purposes of hearing general comments and complaints as to its policies, adopted pursuant to Chapters 4301 and 4303 of the Ohio Revised Code; considering other business and procedures of the Liquor Control Commission and receiving suggestions with respect thereto; and, for the dissemination of information to the public.

Additionally, the Commission will also receive comments and testimony concerning its administrative rules of the Ohio Administrative Code, and particularly the thirteen (13) rules under five-year review for 2018, and three (3) additional administrative rules enumerated below:
